

James Donald

Award-winning filmmaker James Donald has collaborated with John Rubin since January 2000. Starting as associate producer, Donald is now senior producer at John Rubin Productions, Inc. in Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Donald recently produced two films—*Is That Skunk?*, his fourth film for the PBS series NATURE, and *Climbing Redwood Giants* (with John Rubin) for the series NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC EXPLORER. Donald was supervising producer of *Ape Genius* and co-producer of *The Living Weapon*, which won Peabody and Emmy awards, respectively.

Donald produced (with John Rubin) *Raptor Force* for NATURE, a celebration of birds of prey from an engineering point of view. Also for NATURE Donald produced *American Eagle* (about bald eagles) and *Animals Behaving Worse*, focusing on quirky but adaptive animal behaviors in a human-dominated world. Both won Cine Golden Eagles.

This year, Donald helped to produce *24 Hours After Asteroid Impact* for NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC EXPLORER and directed fundraising videos for MIT's MCGOVERN INSTITUTE FOR BRAIN RESEARCH.

Between 1997 and 2000, Donald worked for Lone Wolf Pictures as a production manager and associate producer.
